CO-CURRICULAR NEWS

A reminder about some of the important pieces of information that I outlined in last weeks newsletter.

Sport Program: Middle and Senior Years sporting competitions begin this week. The SAAS association have only sent a 1 week draw to allow teams to commence this week and all fixtures are in draft form, but once completed, they will be posted on the Rostrevor College website under co-curricular. A completed draw for the term will be uploaded next week.

Away Venues: When your son has a scheduled away match, he is required to seek a map to the ground which will be available on-line from the Rostrevor website under co-curricular. Schools do not always play on their actual grounds and therefore it is important to check where the match is being played. I will endeavor to make these maps available by Wednesday of the upcoming weekend at the latest but am reliant upon the opposing school to forward this information.

Cancellations: Middle and Senior Years training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature is 38 degrees or greater. Junior Years training will be cancelled if the forecast temperature is 35 degrees or greater.

FIRST XI CRICKET

Rostrevor 9/129 in 43 overs (Dylan Fitzsimons 36no, Harrison Rahaley 26, Murphy Short 20) defeated Sacred Heart 127 all out in 43 overs (Harrison Rahaley 4/35, Ned McKay 3/16, Darcy Fogarty 1/17)

The First XI faced a strong opponent in an away fixture against Sacred Heart. The boys fought hard and claimed a tough win in a game where batting was difficult, but ultimately a very important win as it was a Knockout game for the State Championship competition. Whilst coach Mr Trewartha wasn't happy that the boys played anywhere near their best, the resilience of the team to grind out the win against good opposition was very pleasing.

Sacred Heart won the toss and elected to bat. Their opening batsmen put on 21 before a mix-up saw us take the first wicket via an excellent throw from the deep from Dylan Fitzsimons. Dylan Smith and Patrick Shrestha were excellent with the new ball and made scoring difficult. Sacred Heart continued to accumulate the runs; however, our bowling was tight and they never exceeded a run rate of 3 per over. At 3/99 with 13 overs to go, a total of 150+ was on the cards. Harrison Rahaley and Ned McKay bowled with great accuracy and were rewarded with regular wickets in the latter part of the innings. From 3/99, Sacred Heart slipped to 7/106 and eventually all out for 127. Our fielding was OK, but certainly some room for improvement in the weeks to come.
