Through our own efforts, and doing our best.

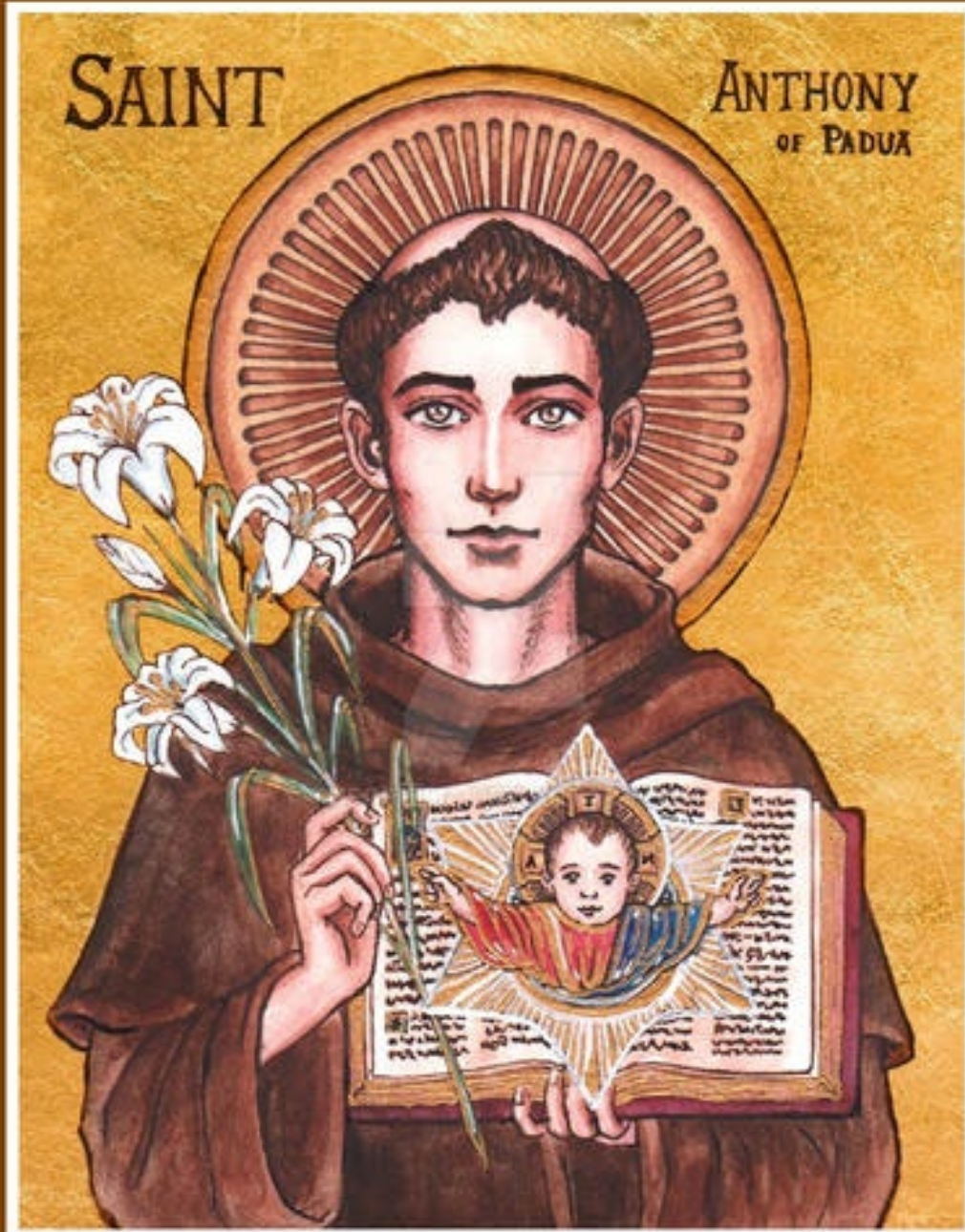
Lord be with us today, Please instill in me the wisdom to recognize the value of education and to never take it for granted.
